The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Dave Alsteen. Roll call was taken with all members present. Also present were Mary and Terry Renel, Jim Valentine and Shane from GAD.

The Pledge was recited.

Mike moved to approve the agenda. Vic seconded. Motion carried

Mike moved to approve the minutes of the November meeting. Vic seconded. Motion carried

Sue Konitzer gave the treasurers report

Mike moved to pay the bills. Vic seconded. Motion carried.

Vic made a motion to sign the ambulance contract and Mike seconded. Motion carried and Dave passed the ambulance contract around for signatures. The contract amount will be paid in February.

Shane from GAD was presented to talk about the garbage contract. The company took over G & S on November 1st. They are a locally owned and operated service and the rates will be the same for 2017. The \$3000/ month is locked in for the rest of 2017. When this year is over there will be a 1 – 1.5% increase. Dave opened up the floor for questions from the board.

Mike asked if there might be recycling pick-up curbside and Shane said that they do that with several cities and towns.

There will be a recycling meeting on Wednesday December, 14, 2016 that will be put on by the county. Several board members plan on attending.

Wally Rusch would like to buy a part of the cul de sac on the river side of Highland Drive that he will landscape to go with the new house he is building. He will pay for city sewer and water but will be paying taxes to the town. The board will need to have paper work done before approval and will need this to be brought to the planning committee.

The board decided that the comprehensive plan materials will be done by a local printer. It will be less expensive and the bill has already been paid.

The fire tender is progressing and the color will be OK. Cummins and International will be giving us a \$2000 refund for the delays from Packer City. Hopefully, the town will take delivery in January.

The town will be hosting the recycling meeting. Dave will be there and plans to get information on "single stream" recycling. That should start on the first of the year.

Mike suggested getting a Thank You card for all the years of service for G & S Refuse.

Dave mentioned that the city holds the titles to the existing fire trucks. The town should pay the insurance and hold the title for the new truck. The clerk will check with City hall to see about getting the titles signed over to the town.

Vic motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mike seconded. Meeting was adjourned.
