February 13, 2017 MEETING

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Dave Alsteen. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Dave did the roll call and all members were present. Also present were Bob Aprill, Linda Aprill, Mary and Terry Renel, Stanley Ostrenga, Rod Fifield, Heather Fifield, Shelly Trevor, Mike Kauss, and Randy Schlorf.

Mike made a motion to approve the agenda, Vic seconded. Motion carried.

Mike made a motion to approve the minutes of the January meeting, Vic seconded. Motion carried.

Sue read the treasurer's report.

Dave asked for a motion to pay the bills. There was a question on the check to K-9 Creations. The town has a contract with Nikki Coopman to care for stray dogs. If the dog is retrieved by the owner, the town will be reimbursed by the owner. There were questions on the propane ratio between the town hall and the garage, the fuel bill and the bill from Community Planning. Mike made a motion to pay bills, Vic seconded. Motion carried.

Mike Kaczmarek presented his application to re-zone his residence from agricultural to residential. Dave made a motion to accept the application and Vic seconded. Motion carried.

Mike Kauss presented his application to annex and re-zone a portion of his neighbor's property to widen his driveway. It will be re-zoned from agricultural to

R-1. Mike made a motion to accept the application ad Vic seconded. Motion carried.

Sue had a letter from R & R Assessing stating that the second fire number on the Heather Hodkiewicz property does not have a livable dwelling and should not be charged for garbage/recycling. Vic made a motion to remove the fees from that address, Mike seconded. Motion carried.

Eric Milchner would like a fire number removed from his property as there is no longer a dwelling on that section. The board said that it is necessary for the county to remove fire numbers.

The board suggested to table the amendment to Chapter 14 of the Plan for further review.

Mike made a motion to accept the Memorandum of Understanding Relating to the Wisconsin Voter Registration System known as WisVOTE. Vic seconded. Motion carried.

The town will post weight limit signs when the county posts theirs.

There is a significant depression on Busy Nook Road that needs attention or a warning sign.

Dave said that the new water tender has been used 4 times already and it looks great.

The plow truck was totaled out by the insurance company but the town bought it back. The town will be responsible for the repairs.

Shelly Trevor was present to discuss the County I Assessor's Plat. She said that she had talked to NEW Credit Union and the assessor, Hugh Guy.

Vic made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Mike seconded. Meeting adjourned.
