**MINUTES OF THE**

**June 13, 2016 MEETING**

**7:00 P.M. TOWN HALL**

- **The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M.**
- **Roll call was taken with all members present**
- **Also present was Randy Schlorf**
- **Mike moved to approve the agenda, Vic seconded. Motion carried**
- **Vic motioned to accept the minutes, Mike seconded. Motion carried.**
- **Sue gave the treasurer's report. There was a discussion about the payment of bills. Mike wanted the clerk to check into the DWD charge.**
- **Mike motioned to pay bills, Vic seconded. Motion carried.**
- **Randy Schlorf was there to discuss the progress of the community plan. He said that it was finished and the biggest issue was the division of land.**
- **The planning committee will decide what is best for the town as to how the division will follow the plan.**
- **Planning commission voted unanimously to pass the plan. Oconto Falls is one of the few towns in WI that is on time with their comprehensive plan.**
- **The land use division is not finalized. Mike wondered why we needed to pass it now, because we are not in a time crunch.**
- **Certain areas in the township were designated for industry and would keep the city from annexing land that belongs to the town.**
- **The comprehensive plan is meant to give a suggestion of what the town may look like in 5, 10, or 15 years.**
- **Dave wants the board to approve the comprehensive plan.**

- Mike made a motion to approve the plan. Vic seconded. Motion carried
- Jan brought up the addition of poll workers to be relief workers. The board agreed that would be a good idea as it will give the poll workers some flexibility.
- Vic made a motion to approve workers. Mike seconded. Motion carried
- There was a discussion about lowering the speed limit on Betts Farm Lane. It was brought up that it was necessary to create an ordinance to lower the speed limit, which means that there must be a reason. Discussion was tabled for more discussion.
- There were two accidents that have not been reimbursed and the board said that it could receive state money to cover some of that.
- Dave said that there will be a recycling meeting to decide what would be the most cost effective method of waste disposal. If the county went with single stream it will raise the cost. The board felt that things should stay the same.
- There was a request to cut the cul-de-sac at the end of Highland Drive. The town would not be responsible for putting in sewer, water and gas. The owner would be responsible for those expenses.
- The ATV signs arrived and the board needs to pick the roads that will have the signs.
- Sue said that Wednesday we should have the link for us to preview on the new website. We might want to put an ad in the paper announcing the new website.
- Road work – Chestnut Road needs to be patched as does Daly Creek. Jerry needs to check on them and patch them.
- There were two bids for the town hall door. J's Construction needs to resubmit their bid to include a new frame and hardware. The second bid was Bear Built Construction.
- Vic moved to adjourn the meeting. Mike seconded. Motion carried.
- Meeting adjourned.
