**MINUTES OF THE**

**July 11, 2016 MEETING**

- **The meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M.**
- **Roll call was taken with all members present**
- **Also present was Mary Renel, Terry Renel, and Bob Aprill**
- **Vic moved to approve the agenda, Mike seconded. Motion carried**
- **Mike motioned to accept the minutes, Vic seconded. Motion carried.**
- **Sue gave the treasurer's report. There was a discussion about the payment of bills. Mike wanted the clerk to check into the DWD charge.**
- **Mike motioned to pay bills, Dave seconded. Motion carried.**
- **Sue gave a report on the new website. There are some additions that need to be made – links to the county website and to WTA website.**
- **Sue has been very diligent in working on this project and the board expressed its appreciation.**
- **Recycling – Dave went to 2 meetings concerning this project. There was talk about "single stream" recycling. That means that everything will go into one big bin and then will be sorted at an off-site location. There will be several of these big bins at the recycling center and people will just throw everything in them.**
- **Dave said that this would add approximately \$20 to the tax bills. This would be a bit less because fewer people would be needed to do the sorting.**

- **Mike made a motion to agree to have Oconto County continue to be the Responsible Unit for the recycling program in our municipality.**
- **Bobbie Krozell's contract is up for renewal. Mike asked who was getting the building permits and Sue showed him the checks.**
- **The contract renewal was accepted and the contract was signed.**
- **Dave learned a few things from last year's road construction. We will bid the construction first and then the black top. It will save money and we can defer payments until the following year.**
- **Chestnut Road will be done this year and Degantown will be done from Hwy C to Gray Lake Rd in 2017.**
- **There was a discussion about ambulance staffing. There should be an increase in staffing because the town pays \$16,000 for service and sometimes there is no one to answer the call.**
- **Vic motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mike seconded. Meeting adjourned.**
