

**MINUTES OF THE
TOWN OF OCONTO FALLS
August 8, 2016 MEETING
7:00 P.M. TOWN HALL**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Roll call was taken with all members present. Also present were Dennis Sutrick, Chad Holtz, Gwen Holtz, Hunter Leisner, Mary Renel, Terry Renel, and Bob April. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Mike moved to approve the minutes of the July meeting. Sue gave the treasurer's report. Vic made a motion to pay the bills and Mike seconded. The motion carried.

Jan explained the DWD charges.

Hunter Leisner was in attendance to discuss the transfer of Sandy Corners Bar and Grill from the present owner, Amanda Boucher. Hunter's mother, Kim Leisner will take over the license until Kim turns 21. There will be a special meeting August 29th at 7:00 PM to give the public a chance to weigh in on the transfer.

Recycling contract – The county had a target of 75% of the communities continuing with the county as the Responsible Unit, but only 73.5% stayed in the program. There was a meeting in Stiles on August 8th to research some of the costs and get suggestions on what the communities want. Mike suggested that there might be a slight increase in taxes in the form of a special charge from the county. The town would probably align with the city of Oconto Falls because they already have the facilities. Nothing will be decided until August 18th when the county board has their meeting.

Jan will get in touch with Hugh Guy to get the percentage for property owners involved with the Cty I Assessor's Plat.

Jan will try to contact Yashinsky's insurance company to recover the cost of the accident that took place on Oct 21, 2015.

There was no public discussion.

Dave will be inspecting the Dennis Sutrick property on August 9th to be sure that he is in compliance and things are being cleaned up.

The WTA Fall Workshops will be in Green Bay and Carter on September 13th and September 22nd. The board will be attending.

Chestnut Road from 22 to the bridge will be totally done. North of the bridge will just be an overlay for at least two years.

Mike said that a bunch of trees near his home were cut down and are still laying there. They need to be removed and the clerk was asked to send a certified letter to that effect to the renters and to the owner of the property. Chad Holtz asked that some branches on the corner of Degantown and CC be cut because it is difficult for his large machinery to get through.

Dave mentioned that the portable water tanks that the fire department uses are starting to leak and will need to be replaced. It is possible that only the canvas will need replacing and the cost of that would be around \$995.

There will be a special meeting at 6:45 PM, before the regular September meeting, for the adoption of the planning ordinance. Then there will be a hearing about the ordinance that deals with access and driveway permits.

Vic made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Mike seconded. Meeting was adjourned.
