

**MINUTES OF THE
TOWN OF OCONTO FALLS
September 12, 2016 MEETING**

Regular meeting at 7:00 P.M. TOWN HALL

The meeting was called to order at 6:45 PM. Roll call was taken with all members present. Also present were Mary Renel, Terry Renel, Bill Kamke, and Bob April. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The special meeting was in regard to the explanation about the access permit and the driveway permit. The access permit gives permission to get on the land and is free. Once that is filed, the driveway permit is issued for a fee of \$50. This is required for putting in a culvert.

Mary Renel asked about the need of the access permit. There are still questions that need to be answered about these permits. This meeting is just a hearing.

Bill Kamke was asked if there is anything in the Comprehensive Plan that addresses the required width for access. He said that the required width was essentially the same as the old plan.

Vic moved to adjourn the special meeting. Mike seconded. Meeting adjourned.

The regular meeting began at 7:00.

Dave made a motion to amend the agenda to discuss the comprehensive plan concerning the access and driveway permits. Mike seconded. Motion carried

Mike had a question on the agenda about information needed from Hugh Guy. He needs to get the percentages for the Cty I Assessor's Plat.

Vic motioned to approve the minutes with the corrections. Mike seconded. Motion carried.

Sue gave the treasurer's report. The DOT payment in October and November will be shared revenues and will cover the road repair bills.

There was a question about the use of the extra poll workers. Jan will be working on a shift schedule and will be meeting with the workers after October 24th. We will have high schoolers helping with some of the services during the election. They will be voluntary workers.

The ambulance contract is due for renewal and the board thinks that it would be a good idea to have someone from the service come to the October meeting. The board should prepare a list of questions for the next meeting.

Vic made a motion to approve the recycling plan with the county. Starting in January it will go to single stream. Mike seconded the motion. Motion carried

Vic made a motion to accept the access and driveway permits. Mike seconded. Motion carried.

Terry Renel asked who will take tires. The fees for recycling them are getting pretty steep.

Mike asked about ATV signs. Jerry Wendt is getting a post hole digger and will be cutting the grass to erect the signs. There is no ATV riding on city roads.

Vic moved to adjourn the meeting. Mike seconded. Meeting adjourned
