

Ordinance 30

Motion to accept the Supervisory District Plan by the Town of Oconto Falls June 13, 2011 was made by Walter Holtz and 2nd by Dave Alsteen. Motion Carried.

Oconto Falls is now in District 21 which is part of Morgan and Spruce has part of Oconto Falls.

Beginning at the southwest corner of the Town of Oconto Falls; thence north along the west boundary line of said Town of Oconto Falls to the northwest corner of the Town of Oconto Falls; thence east on the north boundary line of the Town of Oconto Falls to County Road B; thence southerly along county Road B to Little Beaver Lake Road; thence southerly along Little Beaver lake Road to Beaver Lake Road; west on Beaver Lake Road to Pipgrass Road; thence south on Pipgrass Road to State Highway 22; thence east on State Highway 22 to Waschbisch Road; thence east and southeast along Waschbisch Road to the boundary line of the City of Oconto Falls; thence following said City of Oconto Falls boundary line in a counter clockwise direction along the northern, western and southern boundary line to the east boundary of the Town of Oconto Falls; thence south along said east boundary line of Oconto Falls and continuing south along the east bouny line of the Town of Morgan to County Road E; thence west along County Road E to County Road C; thence north on County Road C to the Boundary line between the Town of Morgan and the Town of Oconto Falls; thence west along said boundary line to the point of beginning.

Ward 1 Beginning at the southwest corner of the Town of Oconto Falls: thence north along the west boundary line of said Town of Oconto Falls to the northwest corner of the Town of Oconto Falls: thence east along the north boundary line of the Town of Oconto Falls to County B: thence southerly along County Road B to Little Beaver Lake Road; thence; southerly along Little Beaver Lake Road to Beaver Lake Road; west on beaver Lake Road to Pipgrass Road; thence south on Pipgrass road to state Highway 22; thence following said City of Oconto Falls boundary line in a counter clockwise direction the northern western and southern boundary line to the east boundry of the Town of Oconto Falls: thence south along said east boundary line of Oconto Falls to Konitzer Road; thence west on Konitzer Road to Holtz Road; west on Holtz Road and boundary line to State Highway 32.

Ward 2 Beginning at Highway 22 and Pipgrass Road and going north on Pipgrass Road to Beaver Lake Road; thence east on Beaver Lake Road to Little Beaver Lake Road; north on Little Beaver Lake Road to County Road B; thence north to Oconto Falls boundary line; thence East on Oconto Falls boundary Line to south Porcupine Lake Road to Fireside Road: thence south on Fireside Road to city of Oconto Falls Boundary lines ; thence counter clock wise on City of Oconto Falls boundary line to State Highway 22; thence west on State highway 22 to Pipgrass Road.
