Town of Oconto Falls Regular Board Meeting Minutes Monday December 13, 2021, 6 p.m. at the Town Hall

- Chairman Alsteen called the meeting to order at 6pm, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- Roll Call, Alsteen, Kaczmarek, Peterson, Konitzer, Mogged, present for the Town Board. Robert April, SR, Mary and Terry Renel, present for the public.
- Peterson made the motion to approve the agenda, Kaczmarek seconded. Motion carried.
- The motion to approve the minutes of last meeting was made by Kaczmarek, seconded by Peterson. Motion carried.
- Konitzer gave the treasurer's report, Kaczmarek made the motion to pay the bills, Peterson seconded. Motion carried.
- Konitzer discussed the need to increase the Treasurer's Surety Bond according to state statute. Some municipalities only cover their treasurer during tax season, they are not bonded the rest of the year. We will check into whether bonding all officers is necessary, or if just the clerk and treasure should be bonded.
- Alsteen reported the new plow truck is scheduled to arrive in March. Our old plow truck needs repairs with some parts being unavailable. We will need to keep it running until our new one comes in.
- Due to the Christmas being on a Saturday this year, in person tax collection hours at the town hall will be held Wednesday December 29, 2021 from 10am to 1pm. Taxes paid by mail is preferred.
- GFL, Green for Life, the company that purchased GAD will now have our garbage pickup contract. The contract remains in effect through 2025 at the current rates.
- The OFFD Contract was presented. Motion by Peterson, seconded by Kaczmarek to approve the 2022 amount of \$53,168. Motion carried.
- Planning Commission Members will be Randy Schlorf, chairman, Bill Kamke, vice-chair, Tim O'Harrow, Chad Holtz, Dave Alsteen, members. Motion by Kaczmarek, seconded by Peterson to approve. Motion carried.
- Poll Workers for the 22/23 season are Robert April, Sr, Virginia Damp, Lisa Gail Irwin, Sue Konitzer, Sandy Reith, Mary Renel, Sharon Wenzel, Barbara Wolf. Peterson made the motion to approve the list, Kaczmarek seconded. Motion carried.
- Public Discussion. Updates to the town hall including windows, siding, and foundation

work, will be done over the summer. A list of needed repairs will be put out for bids in March.

Town Board Discussion. The Oconto Falls Area Ambulance upgrade is set to be fully operational on January 1, 2022. All plans have been approved, the state has done their inspections and all hiring has been completed.
