

TOWN OF OCONTO FALLS ABSENTEE VOTING

In-Person Absentee Voting: (Appointments are encouraged to speed up the process! 920-373-6663)

Location: Town of Oconto Falls Town Hall, 8680 State Highway 22, Oconto Falls

Dates: Tuesday, October 22nd and Tuesday October 29th

Hours: 4:00 pm.to 8:00 pm.

Photo ID is required to vote in-person absentee.

If you need to register to vote, Photo ID and Proof of Residence is required.

By Appointment, In-Person Absentee Voting: (920-373-6663 for appointment)

Location: 5076 Golden Corners Rd, Oconto Falls WI 54154

Dates: Tuesday, October 22nd through Friday November 1st 5pm deadline

Photo ID is required to vote in-person absentee.

If you need to register to vote, Photo ID and Proof of Residence is required.

By Mail Absentee Ballots:

Request an absentee ballot by mail to the clerk's office

Photo ID must be on file or accompany the absentee ballot request.

Returning Your Absentee Ballot:

YOU MUST RETURN YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT IN PERSON OR BY USPS MAIL. Any ballots not at the polling location by 8:00 PM on Election Day will not be counted.

- **USPS Mail Return:** The ballot must be received back by no later than Election Day in order to count.
- **Personal Return: On Election Day,** you may return your absentee ballot to your polling location, Town of Oconto Falls Town Hall, 8680 State Highway 22, Oconto Falls, WI 54154.

MAIL BALLOT ENVELOPES ARE INSPECTED FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- **Voter Signature Required:** Sign the certificate envelope where it indicates Voter Signature.
- **Witness Signature Required for Your Vote to Be Counted:** Any qualified elector (18 years or older, US Citizen, Not a felon) can sign as your witness. If you don't have a witness, we encourage you to vote in-person absentee or at the polls.
- **Witness Address Required:** Even if the address is the same as yours, you must include the witness's address. This means the number, street name and city.
- **Evidence of Tampering: DON'T TAPE YOUR ENVELOPE!** Election Inspectors will view that as evidence that your envelope was opened and resealed as a tampering event and will reject your ballot. Please use a damp cloth or envelope sealant to seal your ballot envelope.
