

Town of Oconto Falls Regular Board Meeting Minutes Monday February 9, 2026, 6 p.m. at the Town Hall

Chairman Alsteen called the meeting to order at 6pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call-Alsteen, Peterson, Kaczmarek, Rieth, Mogged present for the board. Jerry & Gail Schroeder, Mary Renel, Robert April, Keith Meyers present for the public.

Motion to approve the agenda made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as published made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Rieth presented the treasurer's Report.

The motion to pay bills was made by Peterson, second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried.

The application to the Board of Commissioners of Public Land (BCPL) for the 2026 Plow Truck Loan was read by Mogged. Alsteen made the motion to approve the loan application. Second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried

The borrowing resolution supplied by BCPL for the 2026 Plow Truck debt was read by Kaczmarek. Kaczmarek made the motion to approve the resolution, second by Peterson. Roll call vote of approval was taken. Kaczmarek aye, Peterson aye, Alsteen aye. Final tally 3 ayes, 0 noes. Motion carried.

Mogged introduced a plan by the City of Oconto Falls to create a City of Oconto Falls Joint Library. Libraries are a very complex issue. She has offered to be a resource as the board works through this decision. Peter Wills will be contacting the board in the future with more information.

Public Discussion- Keith Meyers asked if there was an ordinance about no more gravel pits in the Town. The Town does not have an ordinance stating that. Jerrold Schroeder has decided to be a write-in for county board district 20.

Town Board Discussion- **Mogged** There will be a spring primary on February 17th, only for Gillett school district voters. COM2 Recycling will have another electronics recycling event here on May 16. A vacuum has been donated for hall use by Rebecca Hinkhouse and the cleaning crew has reported it works. **Alsteen** The board will be driving together to Carter for WTA training on Saturday February 14th.
