

Town of Oconto Falls Regular Board Meeting Minutes Monday April 13, 2026, 6 p.m. at the Town Hall

Chairman Alsteen called the meeting to order at 6pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call-Alsteen, Peterson, Kaczmarek, Rieth, Mogged present for the board. Jason Martin, Keith Meyers, Paul Mogged present for the public.

Motion to approve the agenda made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as published made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Rieth presented the treasurer's Report.

The motion to pay bills was made by Peterson, second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried.

Mogged submitted the paperwork to create a snow emergency declaration during the past snow storm. The board needed to approve and sign a resolution approving the snow emergency. Alsteen made a motion to approve and sign the resolution, Peterson second. Motion carried.

Alsteen received 2 bids for the reconstruction of Chestnut Rd from Busy Nook Rd north to Beaver Lake Rd. There was lengthy discussion concerning whether the bids were same work compared to same work. It was determined Duame's bid was for more work than the bid required. Alsteen will get clarification on the LRIP grant before awarding the bid. The board has called a special board meeting for Tuesday April 21st at 6:45 with this bid decision being the only item on the agenda. A motion to postpone the bid award decision to Tuesday April 21st was made by Alsteen, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

R&R Assessing has scheduled Open Book for April 27 from 2-4pm and BOR for May 12 from 5-7pm.

The Annual Town Meeting will be held on April 21st, 2026 at 7pm.

The Town will once again be holding an Electronic Recycling Event May 16th 8am to 12. This is a drive through event and anyone is welcome.

Public Discussion- Keith Meyers asked if all supervisors are elected the same year, yes according to state statute. He also talked about a product that can be sprayed on the of our trucks to help increase their longevity. Alsteen gave approval to talk to the county about doing this to our 2 newest plow trucks.

Town Board Discussion-Kaczmarek asked where we were going to find the extra money we have spent already this year? There is still a \$20,000 road grant from 2025 we have not received which will help. There is a county recycling meeting at the Oconto Falls City Hall on April 22nd. The WTA county unit meeting is this Thursday April 16th at 7pm.
