

Town of Oconto Falls Regular Board Meeting Minutes Monday May 11, 2026 6 p.m. at the Town Hall

Chairman Alsteen called the meeting to order at 6pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call-Alsteen, Peterson, Kaczmarek, Rieth, Mogged present for the board. Bob April, Mary Renel, Paul Mogged, Jerry & Gayle Schroeder, Bob & Barb Wolf, Wayne & Sharon Wenzel present for the public.

Motion to approve the agenda made by Peterson, second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as published made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the minutes of the special meeting held on April 21st at 5:45pm as published made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Rieth presented the treasurer's Report.

The motion to pay bills was made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Mike and Melissa Bramer will be taking ownership of Club 32 on May 22, 2026. The DOR has determined they cannot be issued a Liquor License until they take possession. A motion to approve the Liquor License to be issued on May 22, 2026 was made by Peterson, second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried.

The WTA has requested all municipalities in the state pass the Roads Resolution they have provided to us. They believe it will help add weight to everyone's request for road funding. The motion to approve the resolution was made by Peterson, second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried.

May 16, 2026 is the date for our Electronics Recycling Event. Alsteen will be on site. Mogged has contacted the City of Oconto Falls for barricades and cones to direct traffic flow and the Oconto County traffic department about potential traffic flow questions.

Public Discussion-Renel asked about clarification on the county camping ordinance. We suggested she ask the county. She also asked if the faded road signs have been ordered and when they will be put up. Gayle Schroeder asked if we had heard anything about the FEMA grant yet. We have not.

Town Board Discussion-Kaczmarek attended the County recycling meeting. It is getting more difficult to break even with the mandatory recycling. The number of municipalities involved with County recycling has remained the same in recent years. July 29 is the OFAAS annual meeting and open house starting at 5pm. The Town is looking for someone to mow the lawn at the Hall. The problem is, we do not own a lawn mower so whoever mows it will need to haul their own equipment.
