

Town of Oconto Falls Regular Board Meeting Minutes Monday August 10, 2026, 6 p.m. at the Town Hall

Chairman Alsteen called the meeting to order at 6pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Roll Call-Alsteen, Peterson, Kaczmarek, Rieth, Mogged present for the board. Keith Meyers, Bob & Barb Wolf, Sharon & Wayne Wenzel, Mike & Tanya Fabry present for the public.

Motion to approve the agenda made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the minutes of the last meeting as published made by Kaczmarek, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

Rieth presented the treasurer's report.

The motion to pay bills was made by Peterson, second by Kaczmarek. Motion carried.

Monroe Truck has pushed the completion of the plow package install on the 2026 back to May of 2027. There was discussion if the Town should go forward with taking out the loan after the 1st of the year, gaining interest, but also accruing interest on the money. The interest rate for the loan is 6%, interest on our savings is 2.5%. This subject was tabled until September.

Public Discussion- Mike Fabry had information on their ongoing project. They did get a fire number and did get a razing permit for the old barn. They are in the process of trying to find a surveyor with available time to survey their property before any decisions are made. Bob Wolf asked about what the Town was making for interest. 2.5% on savings, .5% on checking.

Town Board Discussion-Kaczmarek-1) The next big dumpster day will be held on September 19th. Peterson-none. Mogged- 1) The partisan primary election is tomorrow. It is a difficult election because you cannot crossover vote which is difficult to understand sometimes. 2) The County credited us \$3,000 for the salt we returned at the end of the season. I will wait until we owe the county money and then enter all the transactions at the same time. I want the \$\$ to all show up in their correct places. 3) I am looking at once again doing 2 person absentee events on the 2 Tuesdays preceding the November election. Rieth-none. Alsteen-1) We did not receive the grant for the town hall. We will move to plan B which is to be shovel ready for 2030.
